

Understanding Shelbourne Reynolds Serial Numbers

The serial number on Shelbourne Reynolds Stripper Heads can be found on the back right hand or left hand side of the machine, it is very important to have the serial number available when ordering parts.

6 Digit Serial Numbers 1990 - 1999

584123

Above is an example of a Shelbourne Reynolds serial number, the first digit would be the year of manufacture (1995), the second and third digit would be the size of the machine in meters (8.4m, 28') the fourth, five and sixth digit would be random factory build numbers.

7 Digit Serial Numbers 2000 - 2009

1233248

Above is an example of a Shelbourne Reynolds serial number, the first, second and third digits are random factory build numbers, the fourth and fifth digits would be the size of the machine in feet (32'), the sixth digit is a factory machine type number and the seventh is the year of manufacture (2008).

11 Digit Serial Numbers 2010 +

CVS32100056

Above is an example of a Shelbourne Reynolds serial number, the first, second and third letters show what type of machine it is, the fourth and fifth digits would be the size of the machine in feet (32'), the sixth and seventh numbers show the year of manufacture (2010), the eighth, ninth, tenth and eleventh digits are the factory build numbers.
